Treasurer's Report/Recommendations

the general fund cash balance to \$13,991,813 at the completion of the fiscal year. For the month of June, revenues were 5.86% less than projected while expenditures were 1.80% less than projected.

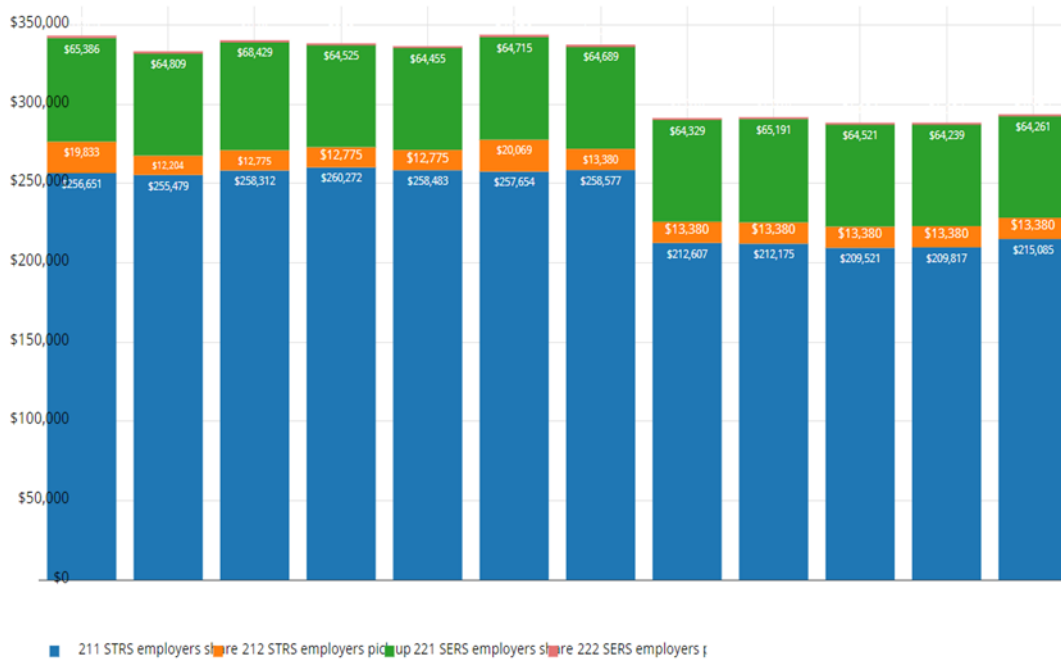
On the revenue side, Restricted Grants-in-Aid includes the special education catastrophic aid reimbursement for FY22 in the amount of \$228,740.55. As a comparison, special education catastrophic reimbursements for the previous fiscal years were:

- \$ 128,087.25 in FY21
- \$ 123,034.62 in FY20
- \$ 173,309.39 in FY19
- \$ 299,671.98 in FY18
- \$ 276,807.56 in FY17

For the fiscal year, revenues were \$91,865 less than projected while expenditures were \$859,424 less than projected. Overall, this results in a favorable variance of \$767,559 at the completion of the fiscal year and leaves the District with a general fund cash balance of \$13,991,813 and an available general fund unencumbered fund balance of \$13,588,040.

Two categories, Employee's Retirement/ Insurance Benefits and Capital Outlay, saw larger than normal variances this year versus prior years. The projections are established in July/August and events throughout the year effect the accuracy of the projections. Employee Retirement/Insurance Benefit category ended the year below the projected amount because of the decrease in the monthly State Foundation STRS deduction beginning in February.

The Capital Outlay projection was significantly affected by ESSER funding as \$115,369 in instructional equipment, typically funded through the general fund, was covered by ESSER funds.

An overall financial comparison between FY21 (last fiscal year) and FY22 can be seen on the attached spreadsheet. In summary:

- Operating Revenues (Line 1.070) decreased by \$1,916,000 (4.40%). This figure is skewed by the \$3,180,000 which was necessary to account for from the refunding of the Leighton COPs in FY21. Without the refunding issue, operating revenues increased by \$1,264,000 (3.13%).
- Operating Expenditures (Line 4.500) decreased by \$362,744 (0.89%) as a result of a \$248,552 decrease in Purchased Services costs and a \$340,142 decrease in Capital Outlay costs.
- Overall, the District expended \$1,504,751 less than it received increasing its end of year cash balance (Line 7.020) to \$13,991,513 or approximately 4 months of expenditures.

In non-personnel related expenditure categories (purchased services, supplies and materials, and capital outlay) the District expended \$633,832 (14.63%) less than it did in the previous fiscal year.

A second spreadsheet is attached showing a five-year financial history of the District. Total Revenues (Line 1.070) are 13.17% greater than in FY18, while Total Expenditures (Line 4.500) are 14.16% greater than in FY18. The District's non-personnel expenditures were \$84,460 (2.34%) greater than in FY18.

The total cash balance for all funds is \$16,822,398.76 with the general fund having a cash balance of \$13,991,812.86. This overall cash balance is \$2,591,043.23 less than that at the end of May which can be accounted for by:

- The \$2,608,264 excess of expenditures over revenues in the general fund.
